## **Tea on The Quay, Mevagissey Harbour**

A newly established family owned tea rooms ideally situated on the Mevagissey quayside, open all year round, their specialities include Afternoon Teas both traditional Cornish cream teas, and for those with a less sweet tooth a delicious savoury alternative. A small, but superb little café in the beautiful village of Charlestown. ## **Duchy of Cornwall Nursery café**

## **Melinsey Mill, Veryan**

A restored, working medieval watermill in an idyllic location. There is a small museum, craft shop and café. You'll find willow sculptures dotted around the surrounding area, with a selection of willow craftwork for sale in the shop. If you fancy a stroll, there's a lovely walk around the lake, and plenty of wildfowl to spot. The café serves morning coffee, light lunches and delicious cream teas, as well as a range of homemade cakes. Open April to the end of October. Closed on a Monday except in July, August and Bank Holidays..
